South Florida Workforce to Host Community Forum

(Miami-Dade County, Florida) – The South Florida Workforce Investment Board is hosting a Community Forum on Monday, November 30th from 6:30pm to 8:00pm at the South Dade Regional Library in Cutler Bay. The event, called South Florida Workforce: Accelerate South Florida Community Forum, is free and open to all members of the community.

The Forum is an opportunity for the community to learn about South Florida Workforce's Accelerate South Florida Recovery and Action plan and the employment and training services that are available to all eligible citizens, particularly those impacted by the economic downturn.

"The current economic climate emphasizes the need for workforce training, which could lead jobseekers back on the pathway to employment," said Rick Beasley, Executive Director of South Florida Workforce. South Florida Workforce offers a host of training options, funded in whole, or in part by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. The agency is currently working closely with employers and educational institutions to offer not only in demand training, but potential entry-level positions to unemployed workers.
