Tuition Refunds: The school's tuition refund policy published in their catalogs will be followed. Notice: Case Managers need to advise participants that they may be required to obtain student loans and/or other grants to cover the cost of the program that they wish to enroll in if the ITA amount and the Pell Grant, if eligible for Pell, does not cover the full cost of the program. If the participant is not Pell eligible, they will be required to obtain student loans and/or other financial aid to cover the cost of the program not covered by the ITA amount.
